Nipomo Newcomers Club has the opportunity to tour the Industrial Technology buildings that were completed in August of 2014 at Hancock College. The tour date is: Thursday, March 19th at 10:30 a.m. These buildings were built using Bond Funds voted for by the community. There are approximately 1000 students, and 38 instructors who teach eight programs: Apprenticeship, Architecture, Engineering Technology, Auto Body, Auto Technology, Electronics, Machine and Manufacturing, and Welding. All of these programs focus on working with students to obtain skills that result in high pay in high demand careers.

Our club will be able to tour the various buildings with a guided tour; and for those who cannot stand or walk for long periods of time, they will be able to stay in the classroom and learn more about Hancock and other programs. Hancock will require notice on the number to expect so please make your reservations sooner rather than later. Because it will be Spring Break, parking will be free and close by. Lunch will be at Olive Garden at noon with separate checks (bring your credit cards).
