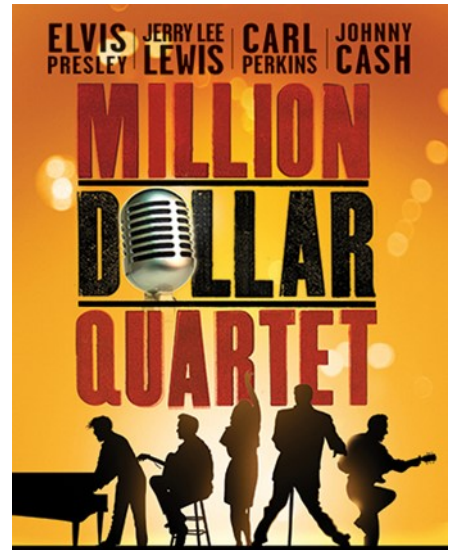
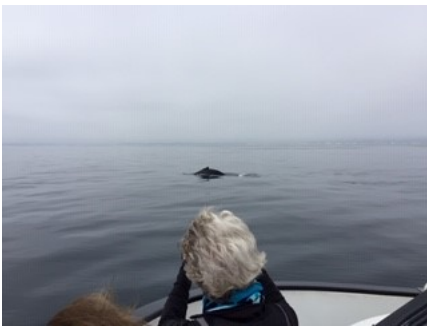
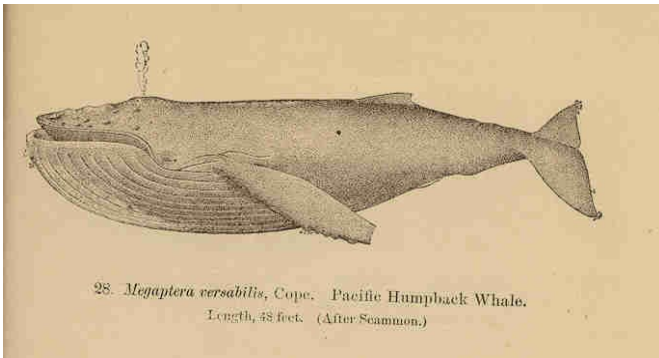


# Club Events
