

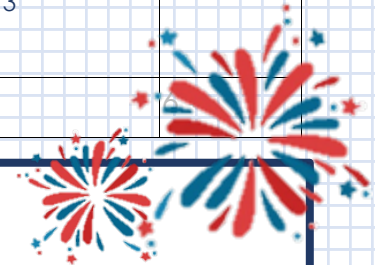
THE TWELVE COMMANDMENTS FOR SENIORS

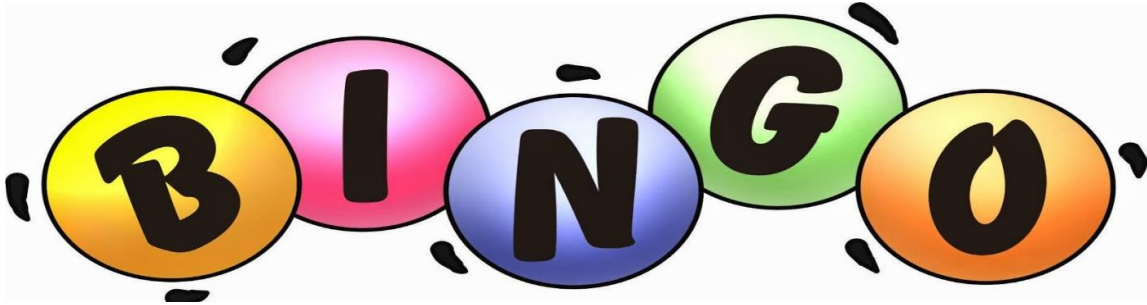
