

LEARN ABOUT... BUNCO 2!

Bunco (also spelled bunko or bonko) is a dice game generally played with twelve or more players, divided into groups of four, trying to score points while taking turns rolling three dice in a series of six rounds. A bunco is achieved when a person rolls three-of-a-kind, and all three numbers match the round number. Each player contributes \$5 for the following payouts to the winners: Most Buncos \$25, Most Wins \$20, Last Bunco \$10, and Most Losses \$5.

Bunco 2 has been chaired by Vicky Sady for the last three years, meeting at the Blacklake Community Center on the second Monday of each month at 1:00. Vicky would like to participate in the Women's Hiking Group in 2023, so she is handing the Chair Responsibilities to Milly Bruno and Christine Williams, beginning January 2023.

NINE & DINE


