### NEW DOMINOES/MEXICAN TRAIN

<u>Dominoes/Mexican Train-1</u>: We have been meeting in the Blacklake Community Room on  $2^{nd}$  Fridays at 1 PM for several years now.

Because of the demand, there is now <u>Dominoes/ Mexican</u> <u>Train-2</u>, meeting at <u>2 PM on 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesdays</u>.

This is a challenging game, with both skill and luck required. We try to keep it at eight players for ease in playing. The goal is to be the first player to use all of your dominoes and/or have the lowest number of points at the end of the game. The number of dominoes drawn at the beginning of the game depends on how many players there are. There are variations to the game, but our group starts with twelve, and each player must match the tile on the board. If a domino can't be matched, the player has to draw from the "bone" pile until they can play. Try playing sometime – you'll enjoy it!
